



1. Topic: Introduction - What is LUKE?



LUKE is a multilateral initiative by EU Member States and Horizon Europe-associated countries to strengthen Ukraine's research and innovation (R&I) ecosystem.

Duration: 01.01.2025 - 31.12.2028

Budget: 1 999 870 EUR (for call management and capacity building)

Call: Enhancing the European R&I system (HORIZON-WIDERA-2024-ERA-01)



Why is LUKE Important?



- A robust R&I system is vital for Ukraine's post-war recovery and economic resilience.
- LUKE fosters collaboration, pools resources, and integrates Ukraine into the European Research Area (ERA).





Definition – European Commission



European Commission (2020)

"Foresight - a discipline of **thinking about, anticipating** and shaping **the future** - facilitates the construction and use of collective intelligence in a structured and systematic way to **anticipate events** and **better adapt to change**.

Early strategic identification, assessment of megatrends, emerging issues and their relevance for policy, exploration of alternative options of what the future might look like and planning accordingly play a key role in policy decisions".














Signals of Change Megatrends







- Foresight is more than prediction—it's a discipline of actively thinking about, anticipating, and shaping the future.
- It enables the **strategic use of collective intelligence** in a structured and systematic way.
- This approach helps **organizations and policymakers anticipate events** and **adapt more** effectively to change.
- Key tools include the early identification of megatrends and emerging issues, assessing their impact on policy.
- Foresight also involves the exploration of alternative future scenarios, supporting better planning.

→ In short, foresight is **essential in policy-making to navigate uncertainty** and make more informed, resilient decisions


