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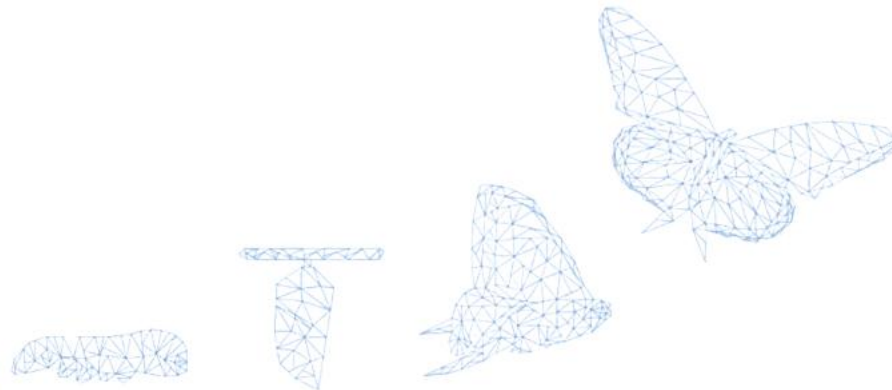

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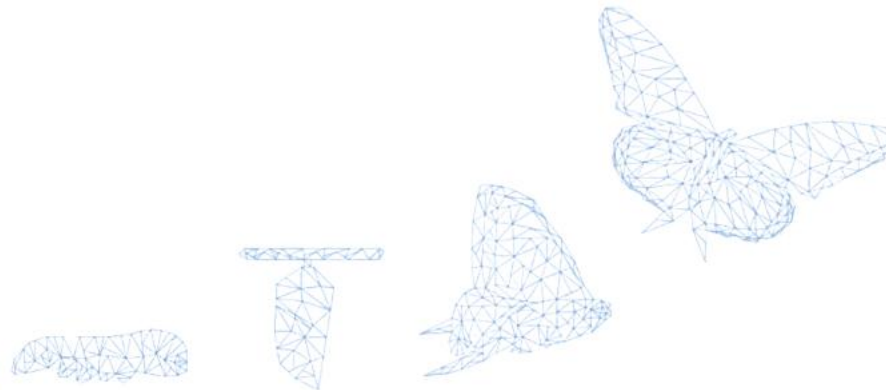

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Recap: STEEPV- The Method



- Social, Technological, Economic, Environmental, Political, Values
- A shared framework for mapping forces shaping Ukraine's R&I system by 2035
- Goal: a shared visual map the whole group can stand in front of, challenge, and build on



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STEEPV: Group Instructions

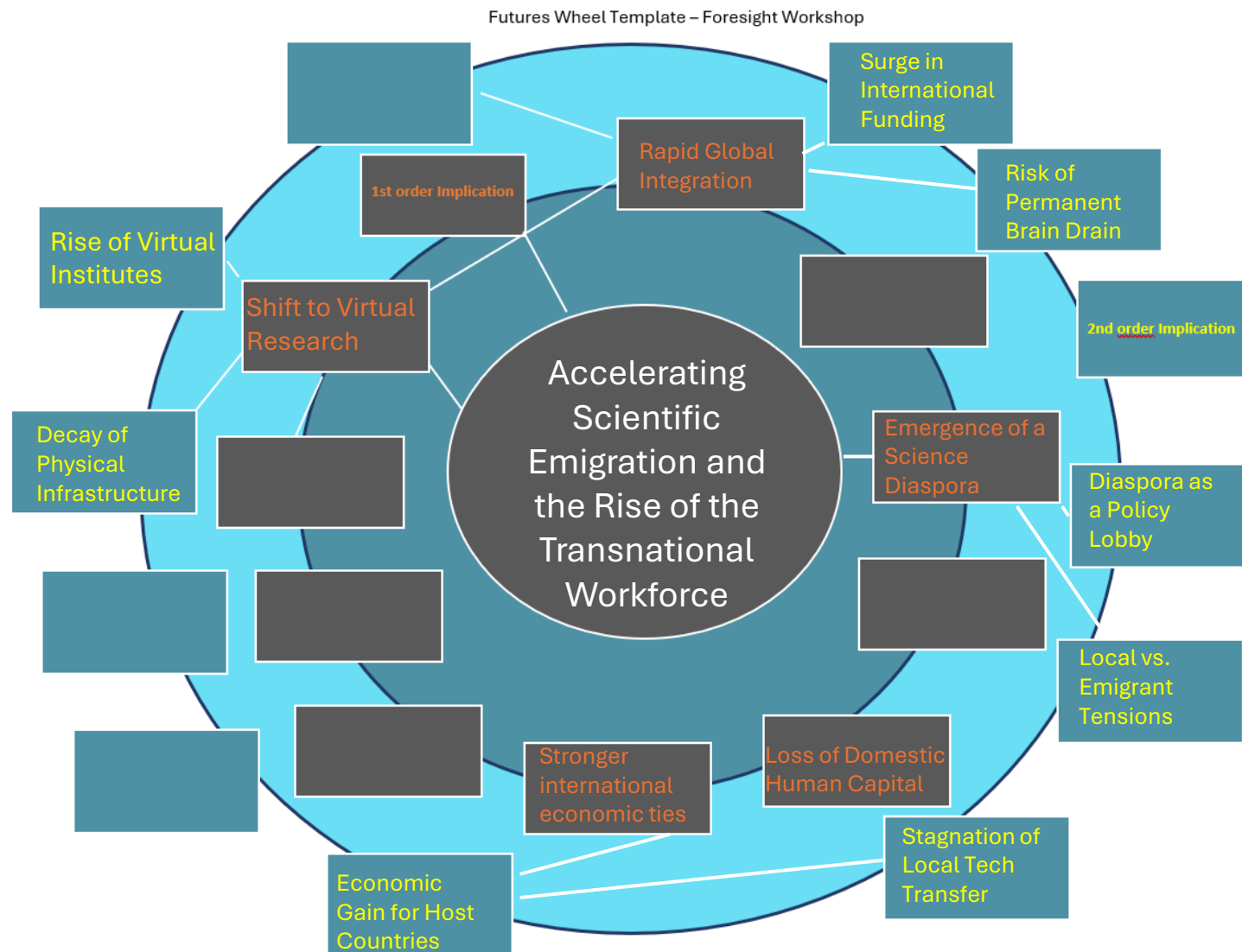


- Write each trend on a separate card, one trend per card
- Cluster cards under your assigned STEEPV lenses; note secondary lens on the card if a trend spans two
- Add new trends as they emerge in discussion; you are not limited to homework material
- Good trend card: states a direction → what is changing, which way, and why does it matter for R&I?

Futures Wheel: Group Instructions

- Write your trend in the centre
- 1st ring: 4 to 6 direct impacts on Ukraine's R&I system if this trend continues or accelerates over ten years
- 2nd ring: what does each first-order impact lead to?
Include at least one counter-intuitive impact per ring
- Mark risks in red, opportunity spaces in green
